Hello Ladies, We are in the midst of our very busy and exciting time of the year. As your 1st Vice President in charge of Fundraising, I want to share with you the fantastic initiatives in the works. I believe we are well on our way to achieving our fundraising goals:

- Provide value added events for all donors
- Engage as many club members as possible
- Raise enough money to cover our budgeted charity needs



Lucille DeSanto, **Quarter Auction** Chair, has exceeded all expectations on this Fall's fun-filled event. Despite the hurricane, the crowds came. Everyone had a tremendous time and lots of prizes were won. Many thanks to Lucille and her team for helping reach all of our club's fundraising goals.

<u>The Belk Charity Days event</u> – Our club has done well with this event raising several thousand dollars over the past few years. This year is a bit

different. The actual sale days are November 8-11th. Belk has terrific sales throughout the store on these days and by purchasing a ticket from one of our members for \$5, the buyer receives \$5 off their purchase AND an additional 25% off all purchases through the sale days (11/8-11). For this event we have 100 tickets to start with and can get more as needed. Selling at \$5 each results in \$500 for our charities.



Our club will also sell tickets inside the Belk store at Lake Square Mall on the following dates. This works better when two people work together.
